- 83% people have very good/good health
- 7 in 10 have no Long Term Condition
- 12.2% provide unpaid care
- 74% under 18's registered with a dentist* (2014)
- 48% adults registered with a dentist (2014)
- 6.5% have a chronic illness
- 17.5% peoples day-day activities are limited
- 9.4% have mobility or dexterity condition
- 4.1% have emotional/psychological or mental health condition**
- 4.4% are econ. inactive long term sick, 3.5% are econ. inactive looking after family or home

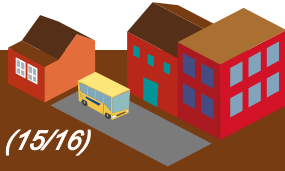
Travel and Transport



- 47.3% households access 2+ cars/vans
- 8.2% travel to work/school by train/bus
- 10% car share to work
- 9.9% walk to work/school
- 0.4% cycle to work/school
- 15.1% households have no access to car/van
- 4.6% of those who work use public transport
- 4% who have car access use public transport
- 71.3% travel to school/work by car
- 0.6% take a taxi to school/work (68 people)

Labour/Economy



- 30 Invest NI Start-Ups (8 in Ballyclare East) 14/15
- 16.5% people have done voluntary work (2011)
- 1 in 3 houses owned outright (2011)
- 264 job vacancies notified to Job Centres (15/16)
- 30% vacancies in Ballynure (79) (2015/16)
- 3% households with dependants, have no-one in employment (2011)
- 9.4% houses rented through private landlord
- 10% houses rented NIHE/Associations/Other
- 10% Income Support claimants in ANBC within this area (210 claimants)
- 12% of all claimants (in receipt of at least one benefit) in ANBC within this area (4,770) (2015)

Qualifications/Skills



- 26% (16+) qualified to Level 4 and above (2011)
- 515 HE Enrolments in 14/15 (75% Full Time)
- 17% HE Enrolments are postgrad courses
- 72% HE Enrolments chose to study in NI
- 145 obtained HE qualification in 14/15
- 11.5% (aged 16+) qualified to Level 1 (2011)
- 1 in 4 (aged 16+) have no qualifications (2011)
