Who is Stryve for?

Stryve is for young people (16-25) who found that traditional education or career pathways weren't the right fit and are looking for a new way forward. This programme is open to young people who are not currently in employment, education or training.

The details:

- Stryve runs from June December 2025.
- We have two cohorts, one in Belfast and one in Derry~Londonderry.

What happens in Stryve?

Stryve has three phases:

- Phase 1 Innovation Skills and Entrepreneurship Training. Learn how to think like an innovator and solve real-world problems creatively. Then, apply those skills to your own business ideas.
- Phase 2 Gain Recognised Qualifications. Earn OCN Level 2 qualifications in Creative and Digital Media, Leadership, and Internet Safety, all delivered in partnership with the Rio Ferdinand Foundation.
- Phase 3 Real Work Experience. Put your new skills into action with tailored work experience in an innovation-driven business.
