You may feel like this:










Location of Antrim Civic Centre



Antrim Civic Centre is located just off Stiles Way in Antrim. The Address is 50 Stiles Way, Antrim BT41 2UB. Antrim Civic Centre can be accessed by car, bus or foot.

Antrim Train Station is located 0.6 miles from Antrim Civic Centre, which is an 18-minute walk.



When you arrive at Antrim Civic Centre. The main entrance is located directly in front of you. If you are arriving by car you will need to park your car in one of our two car parks before walking round to the main entrance

Welcome to The Antrim Civic Centre Reception Area

Here for a class, interview or to use our registry office? Go to reception and they will point you in the right direction.



On the Ground Floor you will find...



Male and Female Toilets. Our ground floor toilets in Antrim Civic Centre are located behind the double doors at either side of our reception desk. To the right is the female toilets and to the left is the male toilets.



The building has a lift located from directly behind the main reception desk. To the left of the lift is also stairs. If you are using stairs, there are 15 steps between the ground and first floors of Antrim Civic Centre.



Behind our stairs and lift is the entrance to rear wing of our building. In this part of the building, located behind these double doors are our two large suites, the Steeple Suite and Whinstone Suite.



The Whinstone Suite is primarily used for wedding ceremonies although sometimes we are able to use this room for various training and classes

Lifts can be challenging to use for some people due to the small spaces inside. Please try and ensure someone is there with you when using it.

Our registry office is also located on the ground floor of this area of the building, it is a small office directly facing the entrance to the Steeple Suite. visiting Antrim Civic Centre to register a birth, death or marriage please report to reception via the main visitor's entrance.



Directly facing our registry office is the Steeple Suite, which looks out on to the staff car park. This is the largest of our Suites/Meeting rooms here at Antrim Civic Centre.

Remember: We are here to make your visit as comfortable and inclusive as possible! If their is anything we can do to assist please let us know as soon as possible!





After using our stairs or lift you will enter our first floor, which is a large open space.



Except for toilets, it would be uncommon for visitors or members of the public to be using the first floor of Antrim Civic Centre.

However, if you are at any stage using our 1st Floor, a member of our reception team will guide you appropriately.



On the first floor the toilets are located in the same position as the ground floor, behind the double doors at the entrance the left and right wings of the building . .

Noises and Smells at Antrim Civic Centre

The fire alarm system at Antrim Civic Centre is tested on a weekly basis, the day varies. An announcement will always be made before the test commences and there is no need to leave the building.

Our building is a quiet and calm environment however if you do start to feel slightly overwhelmed by any part of it just inform a member of staff and we can escort you to a safe place. In the public area of Antrim Civic Centre there should be no frequent unfamiliar smells – if there is our reception team will make you aware of this upon arrival.

All staff will be able to assist you while in the building or using any of the facilities if required.
