## Health & Wellbeing




- 8 in 10 people have very good/good health
- 68% have no Long Term Condition
- 13.4% provide unpaid care
- 3 in 4 under 18's registered with a dentist\*(2014)
- 59% adults registered with a dentist (2014)
- 7.6% have a chronic illness
- 1 in 5 peoples day-day activities are limited
- 11.6% have mobility or dexterity condition
- 4.9% have emotional/psychological or mental health condition\*\*
- 4.9% are econ. inactive long term sick, 3.1% are econ. inactive looking after family or home

## Travel and Transport



- 35.1% households access 2+ cars/vans
- 17.1% travel to work/school by train/bus
- Highest public transport users in this area
- 9.9% walk to work/school
- 1 in 10 with car access use public transport
- 17% households have no access to car/van
- Just over half travel to school/work by car
- 1% take a taxi to school/work (137 people)

## Labour/ Economy



- 33 Invest NI Start-Ups (8 in Glengormley) (14/15)
- 14.3% people have done voluntary work (2011)
- 36% houses owned outright (2011)
- 316 job vacancies notified to Job Centres (15)
- 73% vacancies in Glengormley (230) (2015)
- 3.5% households with dependants, have no-one in employment (2011)
- 8.9% houses rented through private landlord
- 7.8% houses rented NIHE/Associations/Other
- 11% Income Support Claimants in ANBC within this area (230 claimants) (2015)
- 16% of all claimants (in receipt of at least one benefit) in ANBC within this area (6,270) (2015)

## Qualifications/Skills



- 24% (16+) qualified to Level 4 and above (11)
- 800 HE Enrolments in 14/15 (70% Full Time)
- 18% HE Enrolments are postgrad courses
- 81% HE Enrolments chose to study in NI
- 240 obtained HE qualification in 14/15
- 12.7% (aged 16+) qualified to Level 1 (2011)
- 1 in 4 (aged 16+) have no qualifications (2011)
