### Health & Wellbeing



- 79% people have very good/good health
- 2 in 3 have no Long Term Condition
- 10.5% provide unpaid care
- 2 in 3 under 18's registered with a dentist\*(2014)
- 57% adults registered with a dentist (2014)
- 6.9% have a chronic illness
- 21.4% peoples day-day activities are limited
- 11.9% have mobility or dexterity condition
- 6.7% have emotional/psychological or mental health condition\*\*
- 7.5% are econ. inactive long term sick, 3.9% are econ. inactive looking after family or home

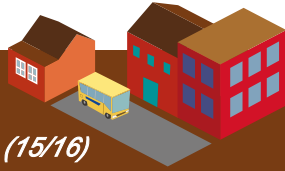

### Travel and Transport



- 26.5% households access 2+ cars/vans
- 10.5% travel to work/school by train/bus
- 10% workers car share
- 13.5% walk to work/school
- 1.1% cycle to work/school
- 28% households have no access to car/van
- 5% of those who work use public transport
- 4% who have car access use public transport
- 61.9% travel to school/work by car
- 3.4% take a taxi to school/work (highest in ANBC)

## Labour/Economy



- 17 Invest NI Start-Ups (6 in Antrim Centre) 14/15
- 11.3% people have done voluntary work (2011)
- 24% houses owned outright (2011)
- 2,028 job vacancies notified to Job Centres (15/16)
- 74% vacancies in Stiles (1,507) (2015/16)
- 5.5% households with dependant children, have no-one in employment (2011)
- 13.8% houses rented through private landlord
- 20.9% houses rented NIHE/Associations/Other
- 22% Income Support claimants in ANBC within this area (490 claimants) (2015)
- 17% of all claimants (in receipt of at least one benefit) in ANBC within this area (6,950) (2015)

## Qualifications/Skills



- 19.1% (16+) qualified to Level 4 and above
- (11) 550 HE Enrolments in 14/15 (66% Full Time) 13% HE Enrolments are postgrad courses 74% HE Enrolments chose to study within NI 155 obtained HE qualification in 14/15
- 13.6% (aged 16+) qualified to Level 1 (2011)
- 30% (aged 16+) have no qualifications (2011)
