**Sound Justification:**

CITB NI have where established by an Act of Parliament in 1964 to ensure the adequate training of those employed in or intending to be employed in the Northern Ireland Construction Industry. Since the mid seventies we have been based at 17 Dundrod Road, on the former airfield. As an organisation we have 31 staff and have 5 tenants (14 staff) most of whom provide training or support services to industry.

Our premises consist of administration areas, classrooms, practical workshops, a canteen, wc's (including accessible toilets) changing facilities, external buildings and grounds and car parking for 160+ vehicles.

CITB NI and its tenants would expect to have upwards of 20,000 persons attend the premises per year with the likely hood of increased numbers due to two tenants (South Eastern Regional College (SERC) and People 1st providing new apprentice training programmes.

We support the development of this area and welcome the potential improvements in infrastructure, especially public transport, footpaths, vehicle control measures, water/sewage supply, electricity supply and connectivity to high-speed broadband.
