

Your journey begins here!



A few days after completing the expression of interest form on the <u>Digital Surge Programme web page</u>, you'll get an email asking you to arrange a time for us to speak over a video call.

This is 30 min call with an advanced technology expert. It's to make sure this is the right programme for you, and to get a sense of what advanced digital technologies may be relevant to your enterprise.





After the call we'll either contact you local council's economic development team and recommend you're accepted on to the programme, or we'll suggest a programme / support which suits you better. We'll let you know which!

Once your council has made their decision we'll let you know. You'll have to complete and sign a <u>De Minimis (funding check)</u> to accept your place.



O5 —

You're on the programme! You'll be invited to take part in the <u>Innovation & Digital Transformation</u> workshop.

Once you've attended the workshop you'll be asked to complete an innovation questionnaire. Based your on answers & a conversation with a consultant your innovation diagnostic report will be produced.



O7 —

You'll be assigned an advanced tech mentor who will provide 6 days of mentoring over the coming months. You'll take part in 3 half day <u>advanced</u> <u>technology workshops</u> (relevant to you). You'll have the opportunity to take part in cluster workshops.

At the end of the programme (after around 4 to 6 months) your mentor will produce a digital acceleration plan, and guide you on your next steps to funding and support.
