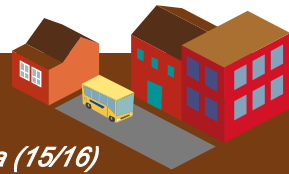

Travel and Transport



- 1 in 5 households access 2+ cars/vans
- 16.5% travel to work/school by train/bus
- 9% with car access use public transport
- 12.9% walk to work/school
- 1% cycle to work/school
- 34% households have no access to car/van
- 12.6% of those who work use public transport
- 57.7% travel to school/work by car
- 1.7% take a taxi to school/work

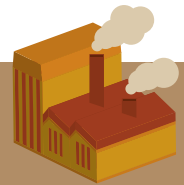
